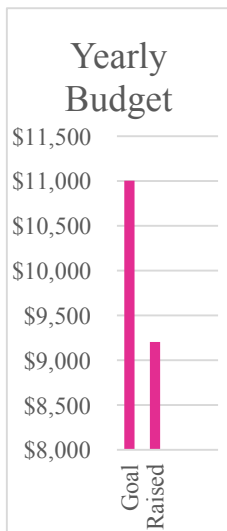

Strong Southern Sunlight
